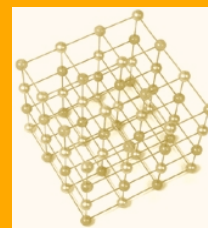


International Family Practice Maturity Matrix

Licensing Information



The International Family Practice Maturity Matrix (IFPMM) was developed in cooperation with the European Association for Quality in General Practice/Family Medicine (EQuIP) and the Scientific Institute for Quality of Healthcare, Radboud University Nijmegen (IQ). To honour this voluntary input the IFPMM instrument will remain freely available to anyone who registers on the Maturity Matrix website (www.maturitymatrix.co.uk).

However, in order to maintain the website and provide the benchmarking feature which forms an integral part of the IFPMM assessment process a licensing fee will have to be charged. Current Average and Leading Edge benchmarks are based on data from approximately 80 practices across Europe and in Africa and are continuously updated.

Besides allowing data entry for benchmark comparisons, the license will enable access to all the user documents on the Maturity Matrix website. This includes a wide range of resources that provide detailed information on the IFPMM facilitation process. The license holder can also nominate secondary facilitators who can operate under the same license. One license is valid for a period of one year and can be purchased for 5 practices at a time at a cost of £250.
